## **Poker Tournament Rules and Timeline**

The entry fee for the poker tournament is \$100.00 per player. The tournament is limited to 50 players. Each player will be given an assigned seat upon entry at the door. There will be 10 players at each table. There will be a 32 inch monitor for spectators to see the standings in the action as well as the players.

The tournament director will begin the event at 6:30 pm. The players will be given \$5000 in chips at the table from the Dealers. The players will be offered the option during the first hour to re-buy into the game for \$100 if they have less than \$2500 in chips remaining. They may also do a double re-buy for \$10,000 in chips for \$200.

At the end of the first hour there will be a break for the players. When they come back from the break they will be offered an “ADD ON” to their remaining chips for \$50. They would receive an added \$2500 in chips.

At approximately 7:30 there will be another break for dinner. At this time tournament players will be able to go to the dining area and enjoy their meal. At approximately 8:30 the tournament will resume until approximately 10:00 or 10:30 pm. Players will be allowed to “sit out” for restroom or refreshment breaks at the discretion of the tournament director.

The “blinds” and “raising” of the blinds will be established at the beginning of the tournament. The tournament director will make announcements to the players as to when the changes are being made. The tables will be condensed as players are eliminated until a final table of ten players is reached. The final 3 players ranking will be awarded prizes according to their winnings. In the event that the game ends before the time limit. The final three players going “bust” in order of elimination will be awarded the three tournament prizes.

### **General Details for the Prizes are:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place:** Mid Sized Flat Screen HD TV

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place:** A Blu-Ray DVD Player

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place:** Personal Electronics Device such as an IPOD or WII
